Her husband looked stunned. He said "What?"

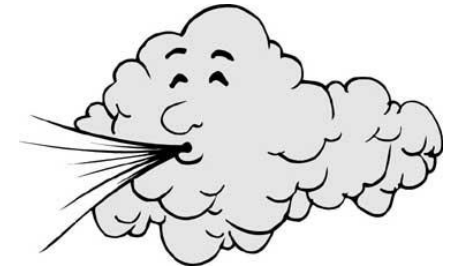
